#### ORDER

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This matter is before the Medical Licensure Commission of Alabama on an application by Gail Roger Williams, M.D., for reconsideration by the Medical Licensure Commission of its Order denying Dr.'Williams a license to practice medicine in the State of Alabama. On November 22, 1994, Dr. Williams appeared before the Medical Licensure Commission with his attorney, Michael White, Esq. The Board of Medical Examiners was represented by Wendell R. Morgan, Esq. and Patricia E. Shaner, Esq. Wayne P. Turner, Esq. served as hearing officer. Dr. Williams presented evidence and arguments in support of his application for reconsideration.

Based upon the evidence presented, the Medical Licensure Commission finds that Dr. Williams has previously been licensed to practice medicine in the states of Michigan and Oklahoma and that his license to practice medicine in both states has previously been revoked and not reinstated. The Medical Licensure Commission has carefully read and considered a proposed voluntary restriction on his certificate of qualification to practice medicine, previously entered into between Dr. Williams and the Alabama State Board of Medical Examiners. The Commission notes that the Board of Medical Examiners continues to recommend licensure subject to such voluntary restriction.

Based upon the evidence presented, it is the opinion of the Medical Licensure Commission that Dr. Williams should be granted a Limited License to practice medicine in the State of Alabama subject to his entering into a new voluntary restriction on his certificate of qualification to practice medicine. Such new restriction shall be identical to the one previously entered into except that the words "and/or other state institutions which are" shall be deleted from paragraph 1 of such voluntary restriction. Upon execution of such amended voluntary restriction by both Dr. Williams, Dr. Williams shall be granted a Limited License to practice medicine in the State of Alabama, subject to such

## VOLUNTARY RESTRICTION ON CERTIFICATE OF QUALIFICATION TO PRACTICE MEDICINE

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The undersigned, Gail Roger Williams, M.D., does hereby voluntarily request and consent that the following restrictions be placed upon his certificate of qualification for a license to practice medicine in Alabama. These restrictions are voluntarily entered upon by me in connection with my application for a certificate of qualification.

I understand that these voluntary restrictions shall continue in full force and effect until they are modified, amended or terminated by the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners at my written request.

### RESTRICTIONS

1. I agree to limit my practice of medicine in the State of Alabama to the practice of psychiatry at state penal institutions under the supervision and administration of the Alabama State Department of Corrections.

2. I agree to obtain the written approval of the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners prior to accepting employment as a practicing physician in Alabama and/or engaging in the practice of medicine in Alabama in any medical practice situation other than the practice situation stated in paragraph 1 of this voluntary restriction.

3. I agree to authorize my supervisors in the course of employment and practice undertaken pursuant to paragraph 1 above to submit to the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners status reports concerning the progress of my work, the performance of my duties, and my

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behavior and relationships with other employees/personnel and with patients. I agree that is shall be my responsibility to insure that these status reports are provided by my supervisors directly to the Board of Medical Examiners, P.O. Box 946, Montgomery, AL 36101-0946, Attn: Larry D. Dixon, Executive Director, in accordance with the requirements of this paragraph. I understand that these reports shall be provided directly to the Board of Medical Examiners on a quarterly basis beginning on December 1, 1994, and continuing until I am authorized in writing by the Board to discontinue such reports.

### PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION

The occurrence of one or more of the following acts or omissions will constitute a violation of this voluntary restriction:

a. Failure or refusal to limit my practice of medicine in accordance with paragraph 1;

b. Failure or refusal to satisfy the terms and conditions of paragraph 2;

c. Failure or refusal to submit the reports required under paragraph 3 to the Board of Medical Examiners in accordance with the schedule provided.

Any violation of this voluntary restriction, if established after notice and hearing as provided by the Alabama Administrative Procedure Act and the Rules and Regulations of the Medical Licensure Commission of Alabama, shall constitute grounds for the suspension, restriction or revocation of the license to practice medicine in Alabama of Gail Roger Williams, M.D., or the imposition of any other penalty authorized by Ala. Code §§34-24-361 and 34-24-381(1975).

This voluntary restriction constitutes a public record of the Alabama State Board of

Medical Examiners and will be reported by the Board to the National Practitioner Data Bank (NPDB) and to the Federation of State Medical Boards. This voluntary restriction may be released by the Alabama State Board of Medical Examiners to any person or entity requesting information concerning the licensure status in Alabama of the physician named herein.
