IN THE MATTER OF: JAMES SCOTT STANLEY, M.D.
AMENDED CONSENT ORDER

On this day comes on the matter of James Scott Stanley, M.D. The Arkansas State Medical Board appeared together by a quorum of its membership together with its attorney, Kevin M. O'Dwyer. James Scott Stanley, M.D., appeared by and through his attorney, Rick Angel. From the appearance of the witnesses and agreement of the parties, the Board finds that:

I.

James Scott Stanley, M.D., is licensed to practice medicine in the State of Arkansas pursuant to the provisions of the Medical Practices Act.

II.

James Scott Stanley, M.D., entered into a Consent Order with the Arkansas State Medical Board and agreed not to practice medicine in the State of Arkansas until he appeared before the Board.

III.

Pursuant to ACA 25-15-208(b) of the Administrative Procedure Act, James Scott Stanley, M.D., and the Arkansas State Medical Board have entered into this second Consent Order to resolve all issues pending before the Board as follows:

- a. The Arkansas State Medical Board agrees that the suspension of the license of James Scott Stanley, M.D., to practice medicine in the State of Arkansas is lifted.
- b. James Scott Stanley, M.D., will comply with the recommendations of the Positive Sobriety Institute as if they were terms of this Order.

- c. James Scott Stanley, M.D., will continue with his Contract for Rehabilitation and Monitoring with the Arkansas Medical Foundation, and will comply with the terms of that Contract as if they were terms of this Order.

Pursuant to ACA§25-15-208(b) of the Administrative Procedure Act, the Arkansas State Medical Board finds that the offer of James Scott Stanley, stated in Paragraph III above, protects the health and safety of the citizens of Arkansas and agrees to the same.

WHEREFORE, IT IS CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the agreement of the parties stated in Paragraph III above is a fair and equitable agreement and protects the health and safety of the citizens of Arkansas and the rights of James Scott Stanley, M.D.

The Arkansas State Medical Board adopts said agreement as the Board's own Order.

IT IS SO ORDERED.



