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FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Board of Medical Examiners of the State of Arizona is the duly constituted authority for the regulation and control of the practice of medicine in the State of Arizona.

2. **STEPHEN S. BROCKWAY, M.D.**, is the holder of License No. 17759 for the practice of medicine in the State of Arizona.

3. On or about May 10, 1994, the Board and Dr. **BROCKWAY** entered into a Stipulation and Order. Term Number 1 of the Order provided:

1. **STEPHEN S. BROCKWAY, M.D.** shall have a female chaperone present at all times during which he sees or treats female patients.

4. On or about July 15, 1994, Dr. **BROCKWAY** appeared before the Board at its regular meeting during which Dr. **BROCKWAY** admitted that he had as of that date saw or treated approximately 25 females and the he had not been compliant with the requirement to have a female chaperone present during those sessions.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board of Medical Examiners of the State of Arizona possesses jurisdiction over the subject matter hereof and over **STEPHEN S. BROCKWAY, M.D.**

2. The conduct and circumstances described above constitute unprofessional conduct pursuant to A.R.S. §32-1401(24)(r) (violating a formal order, probation, consent agreement or stipulation issued or entered into by the board or its executive director under the provisions of this chapter).

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, IT IS ORDERED that STEPHEN S. BROCKWAY, M.D. is hereby censured.
