Public Letter of Reprimand

An investigation by the Medical Board of California revealed that you failed to document informed consent for certain outpatient neuroleptic medications, failed to objectively assess and consider potential introgenic causes contributing to the patient's delirium, and failed to call 911 when attending to a patient in that condition, over the objection to hospitalization, by the patient and her husband.

These actions constitute a violation of California Business and Professions Code sections 725 - excessive prescribing and 2266 - failure to maintain adequate and accurate records.

Pursuant to the authority of the California Business and Professions Code section 2233, you are hereby issued this Public Letter of Reprimand by the Medical Board of California.
