CEASE PRACTICE ORDER

In the Medical Board of California (Board) Case No. 800-2014-009758, the Board issued a Decision adopting a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, which became effective December 29, 2017. In the Board's Order, Physician's and Surgeon's License No. A 81272, issued to KARL BANDYAN, M.D., was placed on 7 years' probation.

Probationary Condition No. 9 – Clinical Competence Assessment Program, requires Respondent to enroll in a clinical competence assessment program approved in advance by the Board or its designee. Respondent shall successfully complete the program not later than six (6) months after Respondent's initial enrollment unless the Board or its designee agrees in writing to an extension of that time

If Respondent fails to enroll, participate in, or successfully complete the clinical competence assessment program within the designated time period, Respondent shall receive a notification from the Board or its designee to cease the practice of medicine within three (3) calendar days after being so notified,

The Respondent has failed to obey Probationary Condition No. 9 as ordered in the above Decision, by failing to attend the program within the required timeframe. Accordingly, Respondent, KARL BANDYAN, M.D., is prohibited from engaging in the practice of medicine. The Respondent shall not resume the practice of medicine until a final decision has been issued on an accusation and/or a petition to revoke probation filed pursuant to this matter.
