Pending the hearing on and determination of the Modified Interim Suspension Order, Respondent shall be and hereby is immediately restrained and prohibited from:

- A. Practicing or attempting to practice as a physician and surgeon;
- B. Prescribing, dispensing, administering, furnishing, or possessing any controlled substances or dangerous drugs (except for those medications lawfully prescribed to Respondent by another physician for a bona fide illness or condition, and only in the amounts and dosages as prescribed);
- C. Possessing or holding his physician's and surgeon's wall and wallet certificates and any and all prescription pads and blank prescription forms, which documents shall be immediately surrendered by him to the Medical Board pending adjudication of this matter; and
- D. Possessing or holding any Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) drug order forms and any and all DEA permits, which documents shall be immediately surrendered by him to the DEA.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that STUART H. TUBIS, M.D. shall immediately provide documentary proof to the Board or its designee that he has surrendered to the DEA his DEA permit(s) and drug order forms. Thereafter, Respondent shall not reapply for a new DEA permit without the prior written consent of the Board or its designee.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that STUART H. TUBIS, M.D. appear at the Office of Administrative Hearings, 2349 Gateway Oaks Drive, Suite 200, Sacramento, CA 95833 on August 23, 2018 at 10:00 a.m., for a hearing to be provided pursuant to Government Code section 11529(d).

This Order, the Petition, the memorandum of points and authorities, and all supporting evidence filed by the Office of the Attorney General shall be served on Respondent, either in person or by a 24-hour delivery service at his address of record with the Board and by electronic mail.

Respondent shall file any response with the Office of Administrative Hearings and shall serve any such response on Petitioner through its attorney of record, Joshua M. Templet, Deputy

Attorney General, 455 Golden Gate Avenue, Suite 11000, San Francisco, CA 94102, by24-hour delivery service and by electronic mail (Joshua.Templet@doj.ca.gov) on or before Petitioner may file any reply to the response and shall serve any such reply on Respondent August 15, 2018. by 24-hour delivery service or electronic mail, on or before August 21, 2018.
