CEASE PRACTICE ORDER

In the Medical Board of California (Board) Case No. 800-2017-038264, the Board issued a Decision adopting a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, which became effective October 18, 2018. In the Board's Order, Physician's and Surgeon's Certificate No. A 78625, issued to Rodney Sidransky, M.D., was revoked, revocation stayed, and Respondent was placed on probation for eight (8) years with terms and conditions.

Probationary Condition No. 1, Controlled Substances - Abstain from Use, requires Respondent to abstain completely from the personal use or possession of controlled substances.

Probationary Condition No. 3, Biological Fluid Testing, requires Respondent to immediately submit to biological fluid testing upon request of the Board or its designee. If a biological fluid test result indicates Respondent has used, consumed, ingested, or administered to himself a prohibited substance, the Board shall order Respondent to cease practice and instruct Respondent to leave any place of work where Respondent is practicing medicine or providing medical services.

The Respondent has failed to obey Probationary Condition Nos. 1, and 3, as ordered in the above Decision, by testing positive for Tramadol on September 8, 2021, and September 10, 2021. Accordingly, Respondent, Rodney Sidransky, M.D., is prohibited from engaging in the practice of medicine. The Respondent shall not resume the practice of medicine until final decision on an accusation and/or a petition to revoke probation filed pursuant to this matter.
