CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Harry Brown of Weston (hereinafter "respondent") has been issued license number

014958 to practice medicine and surgery by the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the

Department") pursuant to Chapter 370 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and,

WHEREAS, the Department alleges that:

1. He failed to maintain professional liability insurance coverage from 1994 to August 1998.

2. The above described facts constitute grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to the

General Statutes of Connecticut, §20-13c.

WHEREAS, respondent has obtained professional liability insurance effective August 17, 1998,

which continues to be in effect.

WHEREAS, respondent, in consideration of this Consent Order, has chosen not to contest the

above allegations of wrongdoing but, while admitting no guilt or wrongdoing, agrees that for

purposes of this or any future proceedings before the Connecticut Medical Examining Board

(hereinafter "the Board"), this Consent Order shall have the same effect as if proven and ordered

after a full hearing held pursuant to §§19a-10 and 19a-14 and 20-13c of the General Statutes of Connecticut.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §§19a-14 and 19a-17 and 20-13c of the General Statutes of Connecticut, respondent hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

- 1. Respondent waives his right to a hearing on the merits of this matter.
- 2. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of Three thousand Five Hundred dollars (\$3,500.00) by certified or cashier's check payable to "Treasurer, State of Connecticut." The check shall reference the Petition Number on the face of the check, and shall be payable at the time respondent submits the executed Consent Order to the Department.
- 3. Respondent shall comply with all state and federal statutes and regulations applicable to his licensure.
- 4. Respondent shall pay all costs necessary to comply with this Consent Order.
- Legal notice shall be sufficient if sent to respondent's last known address of record reported to the Licensure and Registration Section of the Division of Health Systems Regulation of the Department.
- 6. This Consent Order is effective on the first day of the month immediately following the date this Consent Order is accepted and ordered by the Board.
- 7. Respondent agrees that this Consent Order shall be deemed a public document, and the Department's allegations as contained in this Consent Order shall be deemed true in any subsequent proceeding before the Commission in which his compliance with this Consent Order or with §20-263 of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.
- 8. Any extension of time or grace period for reporting granted by the Department shall not be a waiver or preclude the Department from taking action at a later time. The Department shall not be required to grant future extensions of time or grace periods.

- 9. This Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, this Order is not subject to appeal or review under the provisions of Chapters 54 or 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive respondent of any rights that he may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.
- 10. This Consent Order is a revocable offer of settlement which may be modified by mutual agreement or withdrawn by the Department at any time prior to its being executed by the last signatory.
- 11. Respondent permits a representative of the Legal Office of the Bureau of Regulatory

 Services to present this Consent Order and the factual basis for this Consent Order to the

 Board. Respondent understands that the Board has complete and final discretion as to

 whether this executed Consent Order is approved or accepted.
- 12. Respondent has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.

I, Harry Brown, have read the above Consent Order, and I stipulate and agree to the terms as set
forth therein. I further declare the execution of this Consent Order to be my free act and deed. Harry Brown, M.D.
