ORDER OF THE BOARD OF MEDICINE

Jurisdiction

This matter comes before the District of Columbia Board of Medicine pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 3-1202.03(a)(2) (2001) otherwise known as the Health Occupations Revision Act ("HORA"). The "HORA" provides for the regulation of the practice of medicine by the D.C. Board of Medicine.

Background

On June 4, 2003 Martin H. Stein, M.D. was served with a "Notice of Intent to Take Disciplinary Action." The "Notice" contained three (3) charges¹ that outlined boundary violations and numerous quality of care issues which prompted the Virginia Board of Medicine to accept the surrender of license, pursuant to an "Order," on October 1, 2002.

Pursuant to the "Notice" Dr. Stein was advised that he had twenty days from receipt of the "Notice" to request a hearing. Dr. Stein did not request a hearing within the time prescribed.

17 DCMR² § 4103.1 provides:

If a person who was sent a notice of a proposed action pursuant to § 4102 does not mail or deliver a request for a hearing within the time and in the manner required under that section, a board may, without a hearing, take the action contemplated in the notice.

D.C. Official Code § 3-1205.14(c) (2001) provides in pertinent part:

Upon determination by the board that a[n] ... licensee ... has committed any of the acts described in subsection (a) of this section the board may: (2) Revoke or suspend the license of any licensee;

On July 25, 2003 at its regularly scheduled meeting the Board of Medicine was advised that Dr. Stein had not requested a hearing. The Board reviewed again the allegations against him. Based on the seriousness of the allegations, the Board of Medicine voted the following sanction:

<u>ORDER</u>

Based on the aforementioned, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the license of Martin H. Stein, M.D. shall be and is hereby **- REVOKED**.
