	Synopsis: This investigation is predicated on the receipt of a complaint from the ALASKA BOARD OF MEDICINE (Ex. #1) to the effect that certified documents indicate that DR. YOUNG'S Alaska application for temporary licensure was denied on October 26, 2000 due to substance abuse and unprofessional conduct. A letter from the Florida Physician's Recovery Network addressed to AHCA legal indicates that Dr. YOUNG has been a compliant PRN participant. However, since he has retired, he wishes to no longer be monitored by PRN and has indicated that he wishes to voluntarily relinquish his license. Legal requested that a voluntary relinquishment form be provided to Dr. Young as a part of the notification of this investigation. A notarized affidavit from the Florida Department of Health indicates that Subject failed to notify the Florida Board of the Alaska action. Dr. YOUNG was therefore notified of this complaint by letter dated August 24, 2001 to his current address of record (Ex. #2) including a copy of the U.C.F. and initial complaint. A voluntary relinquishment form was provided to Dr. Young by letter dated August 23, 2001.							
	AHCA computer information obtained April 17, 2001 and August 23, 2001 reflects DR. YOUNG is licensed to practice medicine in the State of Florida with a license that is clear and active (Ex. #3). Dr. YOUNG'S Profiling information (Ex. #3) indicates that he is certified in Pediatrics by the American Board of Pediatrics.							
	Dr. YOUNG is not known to be represented by an attorney at this time.							
	Response was received from DR. YOUNG by letter on September 6, 2001 in which DR. YOUNG provided a signed and notarized voluntary relinquishment form.

VOLUNTARY RELINQUISHMENT OF LICENSE

Moreover, Respondent expressly waives all rights to seek judicial review of or to otherwise challenge or contest the validity of the Relinquishment and the Final Order of the Department incorporating said Relinquishment.

Respondent waives the right to seek any attorney's fees or costs from the Agency in connection with this matter.

This Relinquishment is executed by the Respondent for the purpose of avoiding further administrative action with respect to this cause. In this regard, Respondent authorizes the Department of Health to review and examine all investigative file materials concerning Respondent prior to or in conjunction with consideration of the Relinquishment. Furthermore, should this Relinquishment not be accepted by the Department, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Relinquishment and other documents and matters by the Department shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Department or any of its members from further participation, consideration or resolution of these proceedings.
