CLOSING ORDER

THE COMPLAINT: Complainant alleges that the Subject is guilty of aiding or abetting an unlicensed person to practice medicine, making or filing a false report, and exploiting a patient for financial gain.

THE FACTS: Investigation has substantiated the allegations only in so far as relating to the unlicensed person in Subject's office. However, that violation has since been corrected.

THE LAW: Based on the foregoing, there is sufficient probable cause to believe that an actionable violation of Chapter 458, Florida Statutes, or the rules promulgated thereunder has occurred. Under the circumstances, however, this case should be closed by sending the Subject a letter of guidance.

It is, therefore, ORDERED that this matter should be, and the same is hereby dismissed.
