CLOSING ORDER

THE COMPLAINT: Complainant alleged subject of investigation failed to ~~prescribe~~ prescribe scheduled controlled substances in appropriate manner.

THE FACTS: Investigation, through review of the medical records, interview of the subject physician and ~~submitted~~ a detailed written ~~report~~ report from an independent medical consultant, substantiated misprescribing and failure to provide adequate medical records in the case ~~of~~ of ~~one~~ one patient. All other patient situations were deemed to be justified. As to that one medical patient, the patient was successfully removed from the scheduled controlled substances by the physician, albeit through what may be considered ~~an~~ unorthodox medical procedure and with insufficient documentation. A letter of guidance should properly dispose of this matter.

THE LAW: Based upon the foregoing, there is ~~an~~ insufficient probable cause to believe that a ~~actionable~~ violation of Chapter 458, F.S., ~~or the rules~~ ~~promulgated thereunder~~ has occurred. A letter of guidance is ~~being~~ being directed to the subject physician.

It is, therefore, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the foregoing matter be, and the same is hereby, dismissed.
