CLOSING ORDER

THE COMPLAINT: Complainant alleged Subject advertised that a clinical social worker was in his employ when, in fact, the person was not licensed as such pursuant to Chapter 490, Florida Statutes.

THE FACTS: Investigation substantiated the allegation. The Subject, through his attorney, has acknowledged the error, states that it was unintentional, and will not be repeated. A letter of guidance is being directed to his attention.

THE LAW: Based upon the foregoing, there is sufficient probable cause to believe that a violation of Chapter 458, Florida Statutes, or the rules promulgated thereunder has occurred. A letter of guidance is being directed to the Subject.

It is, therefore, ORDERED that this matter should be and the same is hereby dismissed.
