CLOSING ORDER

THE COMPLAINT: Complainant alleges that the Subject of the investigation excessively and/or inappropriately prescribed Schedule II controlled substances, particularly Tuinal and Membutal, to two known drug addicts.

THE FACTS: Investigation failed to substantiate the allegations. The investigation revealed that the two (2) patients were not drug addicts. The Department expert opined that the Subject did not excessively and/or inappropriately prescribe Tuinal and Nembutal to the patients. However, the expert opined that the Subject did not keep adequate written medical records reflecting the clinical status of the patients.

THE LAW: Based on the foregoing, there is sufficient evidence to support a finding of probable cause that Subject violated the provisions of Section 458.331(1)(n), Florida Statutes, or the rules promulgated thereunder. However, under the circumstances, this case will be closed by issuing Subject a Letter of Guidance.
