CLOSING ORDER


THE COMPLAINT: The Department of Professional Regulation, upon review of a drug data survey, obtained reason to believe that Dr. Curtis, the Subject, had inappropriately or excessively prescribed controlled substances, Percodan, to C.D. and J.D., who were married.

THE FACTS: Investigation substantiated the allegation. An expert opined that the prescribing was inappropriate.

THE LAW: Based on the foregoing, there is sufficient evidence to believe that Dr. Curtis violated Section 459.015(1)(u), Florida Statutes. However, the case should be closed with a Letter of Guidance.

It is, therefore, ORDERED that this matter should be and the same is hereby CLOSED.
