CONSENT ORDER

The Department of Financial and Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois, Division of Professional Regulation (Department), by and through Vladimir Lozovskiy, its attorney, and Patrick G. O'Donnell, M.D. (Respondent), by and through his attorney, Daniel L. Fultz, hereby agree to the following:

STIPULATIONS

Respondent holds a Certificate of Registration as a Physician and Surgeon in the State of Illinois, License No. 036-108929 and Said licenses are currently in Temporarily Suspended Status since December 4, 2020 for allegations of inappropriate Controlled Substance prescribing to patients of his private practice. At all times material to the matter set forth in this Consent Order, the Department had jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties herein.

On December 4, 2020, Respondent's Illinois Physician and Surgeon License and Illinois Controlled Substance License were temporarily suspended based on the Department's Petition for Temporary Suspension. Said Temporary Suspension remained in effect since that date. The allegation(s) as set forth herein, if proven to be true, would constitute grounds for suspending, revoking or other discipline of Respondent's license as a Physician and Surgeon,

on the authority 225 Illinois Compiled Statutes, Paragraph 60/22(A)(5) and (17) of the Illinois Medical Practice Act.

As a result of these allegations, the Department filed a Formal Complaint and while the Complaint was pending, Department and Respondent, through his attorney, engaged in negotiations for an amicable resolution of this matter. Respondent acknowledges that should this matter proceed forward with the contested hearing, the Illinois State Medical Board (the "Board") could find multiple violations of the Illinois Medical Practice Act. In the event that this Consent Order is not approved by the Board or is not approved by the Director of the Division of Professional Regulation of the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation ("Director"), this acknowledgement shall not be admissible in any proceeding and the matter will be set for an evidentiary hearing on the merits as if this Consent Order had not been submitted.

Respondent has been advised of the right to proceed with the formal hearing and the right to administrative review of this Consent Order. Respondent knowingly waives each of these rights, as well as the right to administrative review of the Director's December 2020 Order. Such waiver ceases if this Consent Order is rejected by either the Board or the Director of the Division of Professional Regulation of the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation. Respondent has freely and willfully entered into this Consent Order without any threat or coercion by any person. Respondent acknowledges that he has not relied upon any statement or promise made on behalf of the Department except as set forth herein. Finally, the Department and Respondent stipulate that this Consent Order will resolve any and all pending and future claims against Respondent arising out of alleged violations of the Illinois Medical Practice Act.

Respondent and the Department have agreed, in order to resolve this matter, that Respondent, Patrick G. O'Donnell, M.D., be permitted to enter into a Consent Order with the Department, providing for the imposition of disciplinary measures which are fair and equitable under the circumstances and which are consistent with the best interests of the people of the State of Illinois

CONDITIONS

WHEREFORE, the Department, by and through Vladimir Lozovskiy, staff attorney, and Patrick G. O'Donnell, M.D., Respondent, by and through his attorney, Daniel L. Fultz, hereby agree to the following:

- A. Upon effective date of this Consent Order, Respondent's Illinois Physician and Surgeon
 License No. 036-108929 shall be placed on permanent surrender status;
- B. Upon effective date of this Consent Order, Respondent's Illinois Controlled Substance

 License No shall be placed on permanent surrender status;
- C. This disposition is considered a discipline for reporting purposes to entities such as the National Practitioner Data Bank. And Federation of State Medical Boards;
- D. This Consent Order is a final administrative order. The effective date of this Order is the date when it is signed by the Director unless otherwise stated.
