TERMINATION OF PROBATION

On May 6, 1998, Bruce Henry Sklarew, M.D. (the "Respondent") entered into a Consent Order¹ with the Board of Physician Quality Assurance (the "Board"). Pursuant to the terms of the Consent Order, the Respondent was reprimanded and placed on probation for two (2) years subject to certain terms and conditions.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- Respondent's license to practice medicine in the State of Maryland was subject to terms and conditions of probation pursuant to the Consent Order, dated May 6, 1998.
- 2. The Board received documentation indicating that the Respondent had successfully complied with the conditions set forth in the Consent Order.
- 3. On June 14, 2000, the Respondent appeared before the Board's Case Resolution Conference ("CRC") with a request for termination of probation.
- 4 On June 14, 2000, the CRC authorized the termination of probation based upon Respondent's compliance with the probationary terms of the Consent Order, dated May 6, 1998

CONCLUSION OF LAW

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Board concludes that as a matter of law, the

Respondent has complied with the conditions and terms under the probationary period imposed.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, it is this 21 day of June 2000,

ORDERED that the probation imposed by the Consent Order, dated, May 6, 1998, is hereby TERMINATED and is of no further force or effect; and it is further

ORDERED that this TERMINATION OF PROBATION is a PUBLIC DOCUMENT pursuant to Maryland State Gov't Ann. §10-611 et seq.
