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ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On September 26, 2023, Disciplinary Panel B (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and Orlando Davis, M.D. entered into a Consent Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Davis failed to meet appropriate standards as determined by appropriate peer review for the delivery of quality medical and surgical care performed in this State and failed to keep adequate medical records as determined by appropriate peer review.¹ Dr. Davis was reprimanded and placed on probation for a minimum period of one (1) year with certain terms and conditions, including successfully completing a course in medical recordkeeping within six (6) months. Dr. Davis was also permanently prohibited from prescribing and dispensing all Controlled Dangerous Substances (“CDS”) in the State of Maryland and ordered to provide documentation to the Board to demonstrate that he transferred his patients being prescribed CDS to other providers.

Dr. Davis has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of the probation imposed by the September 26, 2023 Consent Order and one (1) year has passed.

It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

ORDERED that the probation and probationary terms and conditions imposed by the September 26, 2023 Consent Order are **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that Dr. Davis remains permanently prohibited from prescribing and dispensing CDS in the State of Maryland; and it is further

ORDERED that Dr. Davis shall provide the Board with an affidavit every January 31st that he holds a Maryland medical license, verifying that he has not prescribed or dispensed CDS in the State of Maryland; and it is further

ORDERED that if Dr. Davis fails to provide the required annual verification of compliance:

- (1) There is a presumption that he has violated the permanent condition; and
- (2) The alleged violation will be adjudicated pursuant to the procedures of a Show Cause Hearing; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
