This document is a Third Amendment to the May 12, 2021

Consent Agreement, as amended by the October 13, 2022 First

Amendment, and the September 12, 2023 Second Amendment, regarding

Dr. Bonney's request to modify conditions ("Third Amendment"). The

parties to this Third Amendment are: Cameron R. Bonney, M.D. ("Dr.

Bonney"), the State of Maine Board of Licensure in Medicine ("the

Board"), and the Department of the Attorney General (the "Attorney

General"). This Third Amendment is entered into pursuant to 32 M.R.S.

\$\mathbb{S}\$ 3282-A and 10 M.R.S. \mathbb{S} 8003(5).

BACKGROUND

- 1. On May 12, 2021, the parties entered into a Consent Agreement for discipline upon the license to practice medicine in the State of Maine held by Dr. Bonney ("Consent Agreement").
- 2. On October 13, 2022, the parties entered into a First Amendment to Consent Agreement which reactivated Dr. Bonney's medical license and imposed certain restrictions and conditions (First Amendment).
 - 3. On September 12, 2023, the parties entered into a Second

Amendment to Consent Agreement modifying the clinical hour restriction and the frequency of the physician practice monitor reports.

- 4. On April 22, 2024, Dr. Bonney submitted a request to decrease the frequency of urine drug screens and the frequency of his psychiatrist's reports to the Board.
- 5. On May 14, 2024, the Board considered Dr. Bonney's requests to modify requirements together with his compliance with the Consent Agreement, as amended by the First Amendment and the Second Amendment, and voted to offer Dr. Bonney this Third Amendment. Absent acceptance of this Third Amendment by Dr. Bonney by signing it and dating it in front of a notary and returning it to the Maine Board of Licensure in Medicine, 137 State House Station, Augusta, Maine 04333-0137, all terms and conditions of the Consent Agreement, as amended by the First Amendment and the Second Amendment, remain in full force and effect.

AMENDMENT

- 6. Dr. Bonney, the Board, and the Department of the Attorney General hereby agree to amend the Consent Agreement, as amended by the First Amendment and the Second Amendment by:
- a) Amending the first paragraph of paragraph 17(b) of the October 13, 2022 Consent Agreement as follows:
 - Dr. Bonney shall maintain enrollment in and successfully comply with all requirements of the MPHP pursuant to an MPHP monitoring agreement at all times that this Consent Agreement remains in effect.

Dr. Bonney shall ensure that the Board receives quarterly compliance reports from the MPHP. The MPHP monitoring agreement shall include a provision that requires random toxicological testing three times a month. Dr. Bonney hereby authorizes MPHP to disclose and release to the Board all information obtained by MPHP relating to his participation with MPHP, which authorization shall remain in effect for any period during which he has a license to practice medicine in the State of Maine. Dr. Bonney shall execute any and all releases necessary for the Board, Board staff, and the Board's assigned Assistant Attorney General to: a) communicate directly with the MPHP regarding his compliance with that program; b) review and obtain copies of any and all documentation regarding his participation in the MPHP; c) communicate directly with anyone who is involved with his care and treatment; and d) review and obtain copies of any and all documentation regarding his medical care and treatment for substance misuse issues.

b) Amending paragraph 17(c) of the October 13, 2022

Consent Agreement as follows:

Within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Consent Agreement, Dr. Bonney shall submit for approval by the Board Chair or Board Secretary the name of a licensed psychiatrist together with a plan for ongoing psychiatric care. Following approval, the treating psychiatrist shall submit quarterly written reports to the Board confirming treatment was provided and identifying any issues or concerns that may impact Dr. Bonney's ability to competently and safely practice medicine. After an initial period of not less than one year, the treating psychiatrist may in his or her report request that the Board modify the reporting or ongoing treatment requirement. Upon receipt of such request, the Board may grant or deny the request in its sole discretion. Dr. Bonney expressly authorizes and agrees to execute any release necessary for the Board, Board staff, and the Board's assigned Assistant Attorney General to communicate directly with and obtain information regarding the treatment required by this paragraph.

- 7. Dr. Bonney acknowledges by his signature hereto that all other terms and conditions of the Consent Agreement, as amended by the First Amendment and the Second Amendment, remain in full force and effect.
 - 8. Dr. Bonney acknowledges by his signature hereto that he

has read this Third Amendment, that he has had an opportunity to consult with an attorney before executing this Third Amendment, that he executed this Third Amendment of his own free will and that he agrees to abide by all terms and conditions set forth herein.

- 9. Dr. Bonney has been represented in this matter by James M. Bowie, Esq.
- 10. This Third Amendment may be signed in counterparts, with all counterparts together constituting one original instrument. Signatures below may be applied and/or saved electronically, and such electronic signatures will be given the same effect as a paper document signed in ink.

I, CAMERON R. BONNEY, M.D., HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THE FOREGOING SECOND AMENDMENT AND AGREE WITH ITS CONTENTS AND TERMS. I FURTHER UNDERSTAND THAT BY SIGNING THIS SECOND AMENDMENT, I WAIVE CERTAIN RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO A HEARING BEFORE THE BOARD. I SIGN THIS SECOND AMENDMENT VOLUNTARILY, WITHOUT ANY THREAT OR PROMISE. I UNDERSTAND THAT THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TOGETHER WITH THE MAY 12, 2021 CONSENT AGREEMENT AND THE OCTOBER 13, 2022 FIRST AMENDMENT CONTAINS THE ENTIRE AGREEMENT AND THERE IS NO OTHER AGREEMENT OF ANY KIND, VERBAL. WRITTEN OR OTHERWISE
