**FINAL ORDER** 

On March 1, 2016 an Administrative Complaint (Complaint) was executed

that charged Mamoun Dabbagh, M.D. (Respondent) with violating sections 16221(a),

16221(b)(i), 16221(b)(vi), 16221(c)(iv) and 16221(e)(iii) of the Public Health Code, 1978

PA 368, as amended; MCL 333.1101 et seq.

Based upon the Complaint and after consultation with the Chairperson of

the Michigan Board of Medicine, the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs

(Department) summarily suspended Respondent's license to practice medicine in the

state of Michigan by Order of Summary Suspension dated March 2, 2016.

An administrative hearing was held in this matter before an administrative

law judge who, on October 6, 2016, issued a Proposal for Decision setting forth

recommended Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

The Disciplinary Subcommittee of the Michigan Board of Medicine

(Disciplinary Subcommittee), having reviewed the administrative record, considered this

matter at a regularly scheduled meeting held in Lansing, Michigan on January 18, 2017

and accepted the administrative law judge's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in

the Proposal for Decision. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the Order of Summary Suspension dated March 2,

2016, is DISSOLVED, as of the effective date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that for violating sections 16221(a),

16221(b)(i), 16221(b)(vi), 16221(c)(iv) and 16221(e)(iii) of the Public Health Code,

supra, Respondent's license to practice medicine in the state of Michigan is

PERMANENTLY REVOKED, commencing on the effective date of this Order, based

upon Respondent's engagement in a pattern of intentional acts of fraud or deceit

resulting in harm to the health of patients under Respondent's care.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to section 7311(6) of the Public

Health Code, supra, Respondent's controlled substance license is automatically void,

commencing on the effective date that Respondent's license to practice medicine in the

state of Michigan is permanently revoked.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that for the cited violations of the Public

Health Code, Respondent is FINED \$50,000.00 to be paid to the State of Michigan

within 90 days of the effective date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the fine shall be mailed to the

Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, Legal Affairs/Enforcement

Division, Compliance Section, P.O. Box 30189, Lansing, MI 48909. The fine shall

be paid by check or money order made payable to the State of Michigan, and the check

or money order shall clearly display file number 43-14-133183.

This Final Order is a public record required to be published and made

available to the public pursuant to section 11(1)(a) of the Michigan Freedom of

Information Act, 1976 PA 442, as amended; MCL 15.241(1)(a); and this action may be

reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank and any other entity as required by state

or federal law, in accordance with 42 USC 11101 et seq.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Respondent violates any

provision of this Order, the Disciplinary Subcommittee may proceed to take disciplinary

action pursuant to Mich Admin Code, R 338.1632 and section 16221(h) of the Public

Health Code, supra.
