ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs The

(Complainant) by Kim Gaedeke, Director, Bureau of Professional Licensing, files this

Complaint against Khawaja Habib-Ur Rehman, M.D. (Respondent) as follows:

The Michigan Board of Medicine (Board) is an administrative agency 1.

established by the Public Health Code, MCL 333.1101 et seq. Pursuant to section 16226

of the Public Health Code, supra, the Board's Disciplinary Subcommittee is empowered

to discipline licensees for violations of the Public Health Code.

2. Respondent is licensed to practice medicine in the state of Michigan.

Respondent has an expired controlled substance license.

3. Respondent failed, upon demand, to submit satisfactory evidence

demonstrating that Respondent obtained 150 hours of Board-approved continuing

education, with a minimum of 75 hours in category one or category six, during the period

of February 1, 2012 through January 31, 2015, as required for license renewal.

Respondent submitted evidence of earning a total of 98 hours of the required continuing education, including a minimum of 75 hours in category one or category six.

COUNT I

Respondent's conduct, as set forth above, evidences a failure to complete not less than 150 hours of Board-approved continuing education required for license renewal, contrary to Mich Admin Code, R 338.2371, in violation of section 16221(h) of the Public Health Code, <u>supra</u>.

COUNT II

Respondent's conduct, as set forth above, evidences a failure to submit evidence upon demand demonstrating compliance with continuing education requirements for license renewal, contrary to Mich Admin Code, R 338.2381(2) of the Public Health Code, supra, in violation of section 16221(h) of the Public Health Code, supra.

Complainant requests this Complaint be served upon Respondent and that Respondent be offered an opportunity to show compliance with all lawful requirements for retention of the license. If compliance is not shown, Complainant further requests that formal proceedings be commenced pursuant to the Public Health Code, rules promulgated thereunder, and the Administrative Procedures Act, MCL 24.201 et seq.

Pursuant to section 16231(8) of the Public Health Code, <u>supra</u>, Respondent has 30 days from the date of receipt of this Complaint to submit a written response to the

allegations contained herein. The written response shall be submitted to Complainant, Kim Gaedeke, Director, Bureau of Professional Licensing, Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, P.O. Box 30670, Lansing, MI 48909.

Pursuant to section 16231(9) of the Public Health Code, <u>supra</u>, Respondent's failure to submit a written response within 30 days shall be treated as an admission of the allegations and shall result in transmittal of this Complaint directly to the Board's Disciplinary Subcommittee for imposition of an appropriate sanction.
