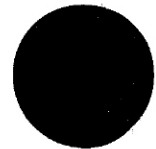

**STIPULATION
AND ORDER**

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, by and between Alan D. Serposs, M.D. ("Respondent"), and the Complaint Review Committee of the Minnesota Board of Medical Practice ("Board") as follows:

1. During all times herein, Respondent has been and now is subject to the jurisdiction of the Board from which he holds a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Minnesota.

FACTS

2. For the purpose of this stipulation, the Board may consider the following facts as true:

a. Respondent provided psychoanalysis to patient #1 for between 1976 and 1981. During analysis, patient #1, as is the usual course in analysis, discussed with Respondent everything about her life, including her personal and familial relationships. Five months after terminating therapy with patient #1, Respondent began a sexual relationship with patient #1. Before engaging in the relationship, Respondent considered his ethical and professional obligations to patient #1 and concluded it was not inappropriate to begin a relationship with patient #1. The sexual relationship lasted approximately three months.

STATUTES

3. The Committee views Respondent's practices as inappropriate in such a way as to

require Board action under Minn. Stat. § 147.091, subd. 1(g), and (k) (1994) and Respondent agrees that the conduct cited above constitutes a reasonable basis in law and fact to justify the disciplinary action.

REMEDY

4. Upon this stipulation and all of the files, records, and proceedings herein, and without any further notice or hearing herein, Respondent does hereby consent that until further order of the Board, made after notice and hearing upon application by Respondent or upon the Board's own motion, the Board may make and enter an order reprimanding Respondent based upon the conduct referenced in paragraph 2. The Board may also order Respondent to pay a civil penalty of \$6,000.

5. Within ten days of the date of this order, Respondent shall provide the Board with a list of all hospitals at which Respondent currently has medical privileges and a list of all states in which Respondent is licensed or has applied for licensure. The information shall be sent to Robert Leach, Board of Medical Practice, Suite 106, 2700 University Avenue West, St. Paul, Minnesota 55114.


6. In the event the Board in its discretion does not approve this settlement, this stipulation is withdrawn and shall be of no evidentiary value and shall not be relied upon nor introduced in any disciplinary action by either party hereto except that Respondent agrees that should the Board reject this stipulation and if this case proceeds to hearing, Respondent will assert no claim that the Board was prejudiced by its review and discussion of this stipulation or of any records relating hereto.


7. Respondent has been advised by Board representatives that he may choose to be represented by legal counsel in this matter and has so chosen to be represented by Paul Engh.


8. Respondent waives any further hearings on this matter before the Board to which Respondent may be entitled by Minnesota or United States constitutions, statutes, or rules and agrees that the order to be entered pursuant to the stipulation shall be the final order herein.





**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF
UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE**

1. The Minnesota Board of Medical Practice ("Board") is authorized pursuant to Minn. Stat. §§ 147.01 to 147.22 (2008) to license, regulate, and discipline persons who apply for, petition, or hold licenses to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Minnesota and is further authorized pursuant to Minn. Stat. §§ 214.10 and 214.103 (2008) to review complaints against physicians, to refer such complaints to the Attorney General's Office, and to initiate appropriate disciplinary action.

2. Dr. Alan D. Serposs ("Respondent"), has been and now is subject to the jurisdiction of the Board from which he holds a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Minnesota.

3. Respondent's medical license was conditioned pursuant to a Stipulation and Order dated May 13, 1995, based upon Respondent's unethical and unprofessional conduct in violation of Minn. Stat. §§ 147.091, subd. 1 (g), and (k), (1994). Respondent was reprimanded and required to pay a civil penalty of \$6,000.00.

4. The Board has received payment from Respondent in the amount of \$6,000.00, in full satisfaction of his civil penalty, and concludes that Respondent has complied with the terms and conditions imposed upon his license.


5. In disciplinary orders in which the remedy consists of a reprimand and payment of a civil penalty, the authority to sign an Administrative Order of Unconditional License has been delegated by the Board to its Executive Director.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that an unconditional license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Minnesota be administratively conferred upon Respondent, such license to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.
