Whereas, after the above-mentioned incident, Dr. Blake surrendered his license to practice medicine in North Carolina, and

Whereas Dr. Blake has undergone intensive outpatient treatment and continues in therapy, and

Whereas Dr. Blake has taken steps and has agreed to take further steps to ensure the Board and the people of North Carolina that he can safely practice medicine, and

Whereas Dr. Blake desires to resolve this matter without the need for more formal proceedings, and

Whereas the Board has determined that it is in the public

interest to resolve this matter as set forth below:

Now, therefore, with Dr. Blake's consent, it is ORDERED that:

- 1. The Board shall issue Dr. Blake a license dated to expire at 11:59:59 p.m. on June 15, 1996.
- 2. Dr. Blake shall practice only in a structured setting approved in writing by the President of the Board, which approval the Board and its President are under no obligation to give.
 - 3. Dr. Blake shall limit his practice to male patients only.
- 4. Dr. Blake shall appear at an informal interview before the Board or a committee or panel of the Board at its May, 1996, meeting, and at such other times as requested by the Board.
- 5. Dr. Blake shall notify the Board in writing of any change in his residence or practice addresses within ten (10) days of the change.
 - 6. Dr. Blake shall obey all laws.
- 7. If Dr. Blake fails to comply with any of the terms of this Consent Order, that failure shall constitute unprofessional conduct and shall be grounds, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-14(a)(6), after any required notice and hearing, for the Board to annul, suspend, revoke, condition, or limit his license to practice medicine or to deny any application he might make in the future or then have pending for a license to practice medicine.
- 8. This Consent Order shall take effect immediately upon its execution by both Dr. Blake and the Board, and it shall continue in effect until specifically ordered otherwise by the Board.
 - 9. Dr. Blake hereby waives any requirement under any law or

rule that this Consent Order be served on him.

10. Upon execution by Dr. Blake and the Board, this Consent Order shall become a public record within the meaning of Chapter 132 of the North Carolina General Statutes and shall be subject to public inspection and dissemination pursuant to the provisions thereof.

This matter is before the North Carolina Medical Board (hereinafter Board) regarding the request of Daniel Jackson Blake, M.D. (hereinafter Dr. Blake), holder of license number 23830, for modifications to his 1995 Consent Order to allow him to see female patients.

Whereas Dr. Blake was issued a temporary license to practice medicine in North Carolina on June 14, 1995 to expire June 15, 1996, pursuant to a Consent Order of the same date (hereinafter 1995 Consent Order), and

Whereas Dr. Blake has been practicing since the issuance of his temporary medical license and is apparently doing well, and

Whereas the Board believes Dr. Blake can safely see female patients under the limited circumstances set forth below, and

Whereas the Board and Dr. Blake have agreed to substitute the numbered paragraphs of this Consent Order for the numbered paragraphs of the above-mentioned June Consent Order.

Now, therefore, with Dr. Blake's consent, it is ORDERED that:

- - 2. Dr. Blake shall limit his practice to male patients only, except:
 - a. Dr. Blake may interview female patients in the Admissions area, in the continuous presence of the admitting nurse, when the admitting nurse is confronted with a psychiatric issue that may affect the patient's readiness and appropriateness for admission to the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Treatment Center.
 - b. Dr. Blake may interview female patients on the ward, in the continuous presence of the patient's counselor, medical officer, or murse in order to carry out a psychiatric consultation that has as its only purpose the making a psychiatric diagnosis or making treatment recommendations for use by the actual direct care staff, not by Dr. Blake.
 - c. Dr. Blake may interview female patients on the wards, in the continuous presence of the nurse or nurses, when summoned as the on-call physician, after hours, for the purpose of providing acute medical attention as needed, or determining whether emergency medical referral is indicated.
- 3. Dr. Blake shall appear at an informal interview before the Board or a committee or panel of the Board at its May, 1996, meeting, and at such other times as requested by the Board.
- 4. Dr. Blake shall notify the Board in writing of any change in his residence or practice addresses within ten (10) days of the change.
 - 5. Dr. Blake shall obey all laws.

6. If Dr. Blake fails to comply with any of the terms of this Consent Order, that failure shall constitute unprofessional conduct within the meaning of N.C. Gen. Stat. §90-14(a)(6) and shall be grounds, after any required notice and hearing, for this Board to gange, suspend, revoke, condition, or limit his license to practice medicine or to deny any application he might make or then have pending for a license to practice medicine.

7. This Consent Order shall take effect immediately upon its execution by both Dr. Blake and the Board, and it shall continue in effect until specifically ordered otherwise by the Board.

8. The terms and conditions in the numbered paragraphs of this Consent Order supersede and replace those in the above-mentioned June 14, 1995, Consent Order regarding Dr. Blake.
