Stat. § 90-14(a)(6) and grounds exist under that section of the General Statutes for the Board to annul, suspend, revoke, condition, or limit Dr. Wangelin's license to practice medicine in North Carolina, and

Whereas Dr. Wangelin has met with the Medical Director of the North Carolina Physician's Health Program (hereinafter NCPHP) and has agreed to follow his recommendations, and

Whereas Dr. Wangelin desires to resolve this matter without need for more formal proceedings, and

Whereas the Board has determined that it is in the public interest to resolve this matter as set forth below:

- 1. Dr. Wangelin's license to practice medicine be and hereby is SUSPENDED for one (1) year from the effective date of this Consent Order.
- 2. Dr. Wangelin shall appear before members of the Board at its November, 1996, meeting, and at such other times as the Board may request, for an informal interview.
- 3. At its November meeting, the Board shall consider staying the remainder of the suspension of Dr. Wangelin's license, depending upon Dr. Wangelin's compliance with this Consent Order and the information contained in the reports provided pursuant hereto. The decision to stay the remainder of the suspension shall be within the sole discretion of the Board. Dr. Wangelin hereby acknowledges that no promises or assurances have been given, by the Board or anyone acting on its behalf, that the Board will decide to stay the remainder of the suspension.
- 4. Dr. Wangelin shall sign a contract with the NCPHP and abide by its terms, including those for the payment of any fees imposed by NCPHP.
- 5. Dr. Wangelin shall continue treatment and supervision by his psychiatrist and shall cause his psychiatrist to submit reports to the Board on a monthly basis.

- 6. Dr. Wangelin shall cause his clinical supervisor to submit reports to the Board on a monthly basis.
- 7. Dr. Wangelin shall cause reports from NCPHP and Gene Abel, MD to be submitted to the Board no later than November 1, 1996.
 - 8. Dr. Wangelin shall obey all laws.
- 9. Dr. Wangelin shall notify the Board in writing of any change in his residence or practice addresses within ten (10) days of the change.
- 10. If Dr. Wangelin fails to comply with any of the terms of this Consent Order, that failure shall constitute unprofessional conduct and shall be grounds, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-14(a)(6), after any required notice and hearing, for the Board to annul, suspend, revoke, condition, or limit Dr. Wangelin's license to practice medicine or to deny any application he might make or then have pending for a license to practice medicine.
- 11. This Consent Order shall take effect immediately upon its execution by both Dr. Wangelin and the Board, and it shall continue in effect until specifically ordered otherwise by the Board. The expiration of the suspension called for herein or any stay thereof
