Dear Dr. Palumbo:

The North Carolina Medical Board ("Board") has concluded its investigation related to concerns regarding your medical record documentation. It is the Board's decision not to commence formal proceedings against your license at this time. However, the Board voted to issue you this public letter of concern. The Board does not consider a public letter of concern to be a disciplinary action/sanction or a limitation or restriction on your license.

On May 21, 2021, the Board received a complaint from a pharmacist regarding a prescription you wrote to a North Carolina patient.

The Board, concerned that your care of Patient A may have failed to conform to the standards of acceptable and prevailing medical practice in North Carolina, requested 9 additional patient records, Patients B through J, in order to better evaluate your practice.

The Board had your care of Patients A through J reviewed by an independent medical expert. The reviewing expert believes that your medical record keeping practice needs improvement. Specifically, the reviewing expert believes that your medical records should more clearly document your patient encounters. The Board acknowledges and appreciates that you have indicated you will take proactive steps to make such improvements.

The Board urges you to take steps to ensure the conduct giving rise to the Board's concerns does not happen again. Otherwise, the Board may take action against your license to practice medicine. If that happens, this letter may be reviewed in determining the appropriate action.

This letter is a public record within the meaning of Chapter 132 of the North Carolina General Statutes and is subject to public inspection and dissemination as required by that law. It will be reported to the Federation of State Medical Boards.
