On November 23, 2007, in a Private Letter Agreement with the State Board of Medical Examiners, Respondent Michael Tricarico, M.D. voluntarily surrendered his medical license to be deemed a retirement. At that time, there was a concern regarding an impairment in Respondent's cognitive functioning skills. In the fall of 2008, Respondent had a cardiac pacemaker installed with progressive improvement in his cognitive functioning. A reevaluation by Dr. Jill Brooks, PhD., Head to Head Consultant, PA and a second evaluation by John Verdon, M.D. opined that Respondent was fit to return to the practice of psychiatry.

The Board is satisfied that Respondent is now able to return to the practice of psychiatry, and;

The Board having determined that the within Order is

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adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare,

IT IS ON THIS 20TH day of JUNE, 2011,

1. Michael Tricarico, M.D. is hereby granted an unrestricted license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey.
