MD23069 6 7 1. 8 9 The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, 10 regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the State of 11 Oregon. Walker Bryan Dixon, III, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the State of Oregon. 12 2. 13 On December 15, 2022, the Board issued a Complaint and Notice of Proposed 14 Disciplinary Action (Notice) in which the Board proposed to take disciplinary action against 15 Licensee pursuant to ORS 677.205(2), including reprimand; \$10,000 civil penalty; six-month 16 license suspension; license restriction to prohibit all intravenous therapies; and assessment of 17 costs of any contested case hearing on the matter not to exceed \$30,000. The Board proposed to 18 take this disciplinary action for violations of the Medical Practice Act, specifically: ORS 19 677.190(1)(a) unprofessional or dishonorable conduct, as defined in ORS 677.188(4)(a) any 20 conduct or practice which does or might constitute a danger to the health or safety of a patient, 21 ORS 677.188(4)(b) willful performance of a medical treatment which is contrary to medical 22 standards, and ORS 677.188(4)(c) administration of unnecessary treatment, failing to obtain 23 consultations inconsistent with the standard of care, and otherwise utilizing medical service for 24 treatment which is or may be considered inappropriate or unnecessary; ORS 677.190(9) making 25 statements that the licensee knows, or with reasonable care should know, are false or misleading 26 regarding the efficacy or value of the medicine or treatment prescribed or administered by the 27 licensee or at licensee's direction for the treatment of any disease or condition; and ORS 28 677.190(13) gross or repeated negligence in the practice of medicine.

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2 Licensee and the Board desire to settle this matter by entry of this Stipulated Order. 3 Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative 4 Procedures Act (chapter 183), Oregon Revised Statutes. Licensee fully and finally waives the 5 right to a contested case hearing and any appeal therefrom by the signing of and entry of this 6 Order in the Board's records. Licensee neither admits nor denies, but the Board finds that 7 Licensee's conduct as described in the December 15, 2022, Complaint and Notice of Proposed 8 Disciplinary Action violated ORS 677.190(1)(a), as defined by ORS 677.188(4)(a), 9 ORS 677.188(4)(b) and ORS 677.188(4)(c); ORS 677.190(9); and ORS 677.190(13). Licensee 10 understands that this Order is a public record and is a disciplinary action that is reportable to the 11 National Practitioner Data Bank and the Federation of State Medical Boards. Licensee 12 understands the terms of this Order and signs freely, without fraud or duress.

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Licensee and the Board agree to resolve this matter by the entry of this Stipulated Order subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 4.1 Licensee is reprimanded.
- 4.2 Licensee must pay a civil penalty of \$5,000 within 90 days of the effective date of this Order.
- 4.3 Licensee must neither personally administer nor direct or order another health care provider to administer parenteral infusion treatments to any patient.
- 4.4 At the discretion of the Board or its designees, random, no notice chart audits and office visits may be conducted by Board designees.
- 4.5 Licensee must inform the Compliance Section of the Board of any and all practice sites, as well as any changes in practice address(es), employment, or practice status within 10 business days. Additionally, Licensee must notify the Compliance Section of any changes in contact information within 10 business days.
- 4.6 Licensee must obey all federal and Oregon state laws and regulations pertaining to the practice of medicine.
