8	1.
9	The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing,
10	regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the State of
11	Oregon. On April 5, 2022, Anthony Salvatore Cull, MD (Applicant) applied for an unlimited
12	license to practice medicine in Oregon.
13	2.
14	On September 13, 2023, the Board issued Applicant a Notice of Intent to Deny License in
15	which the Board proposed denying Applicant's application for a license to practice medicine in
16	the State of Oregon because he failed to make an application establishing that he is of good
17	moral character pursuant to ORS 677.100(1)(d) and (3). The Board further proposed refusing a
18	medical license to Applicant as discipline, assessing a civil penalty of \$10,000 against him, and
19	assessing the costs of these proceedings against him, all under ORS 677.190 and 677.205(2) for
20	violations of the Medical Practice Act, as follows: ORS 677.190(8) misrepresentation in
21	applying for a license or registration; ORS 677.190(17) willfully violating a Board statute,
22	specifically, ORS 677.080(1), which prohibits knowingly make any false statement or
23	representation on a matter; and ORS 677.190(17) failing to comply with a board request during
24	an investigation ("pursuant to ORS 677.320"), as further specified in OAR 847-001-0024(1),
25	"Licensees and applicants must comply with a Board investigation, including truthfully
26	responding to inquiries * * * Failure to comply with a Board investigation violates ORS
27	677.190(17)* * * *."

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1 3. 2 Applicant and the Board desire to settle this matter by the entry of this Stipulated Order. 3 Applicant understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative 4 Procedures Act (Oregon Revised Statutes chapter 183), and fully and finally waives the right to a 5 contested case hearing and any appeal therefrom by the signing and entry of this Order in the 6 Board's records. Applicant neither admits nor denies, but the Board finds that Applicant failed 7 to qualify for licensure under ORS 677.100(1)(d) and (3), and that Applicant engaged in conduct 8 as described in the September 13, 2023, Notice of Intent to Deny License Application, and that 9 this conduct violated the Medical Practice Act, to wit ORS 677.190(8); ORS 677.190(17), specifically, ORS 677.080(1), and as further specified in OAR 847-001-0024(1). Applicant 10 understands that this Order is a public record and is a disciplinary action that is reportable to the 11 National Practitioner Data Bank and the Federation of State Medical Boards. Applicant 12 13 understands the terms of this Order and signs freely, without fraud or duress. 4. 14 Applicant and the Board agree that the Board will close this investigation and resolve this 15 16 matter by entry of this Stipulated Order, subject to the following conditions: 17 4.1 Applicant is reprimanded. Applicant's application for an Oregon medical license is denied. 4.2 18 Applicant agrees to never reapply for a medical license in the State of Oregon. 4.3 19 Applicant must obey all federal and Oregon state laws and regulations pertaining 20 4.4 to the practice of medicine. 21 Applicant stipulates and agrees that any violation of the terms of this Order shall 22 4.5 be grounds for further disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17). 23 111 24 25 111 26 111 111 27
