10	regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the State of				
11	Oregon. John Osmond Lipkin, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the State of Oregon,				
12	practicing in Eugene, Oregon, with lifetime board certification in psychiatry.

14	The Board opened an investigation after receiving credible information regarding				
15	Licensee's possible violation of the Medical Practice Act, specifically his prescribing practices.				
16	During the course of the Board's investigation, evidence demonstrated that Licensee has been				
17	practicing as a primary care provider and outside the scope of practice for a psychiatrist,1				
18	including but not limited to: prescribing and monitoring antiretroviral medications, prescribing				
19	opioids for chronic pain patients, and prescribing methadone for opioid maintenance. In addition,				
20	Licensee's prescribing has been outside the standard of practice for safe opioid prescribing				
21	established by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

23	Licensee and the Board desire to settle this matter by the entry of this Stipulated Order.				
24	Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative				
25	Procedures Act (Oregon Revised Statutes chapter 183) and, by the signing and issuance of this				
26	Order, Licensee fully and finally waives the right to a contested case hearing, understands and

acknowledges that this Order is not subject to judicial review, and acknowledges and agrees that 1 this Order was signed freely, without fraud or duress. Licensee neither admits nor denies, but the 2 3 Board finds that Licensee engaged in conduct that violated the Medical Practice Act, to wit: ORS 677.190(1)(a) as defined by ORS 677.188(4)(a) and ORS 677.188(4)(c); ORS 677.190(13); 4 5 and ORS 677.190(24). Licensee understands that this Order is a public record and is a disciplinary action that is reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank and the Federation of 6 7 State Medical Boards. 4. 8 9 Licensee and the Board agree that the Board will close this investigation and resolve this 10 matter by entry of this Stipulated Order, subject to the following conditions: 11 4.1 Licensee retires his Oregon medical license while under investigation and ceases 12 the practice of medicine no later than August 30, 2024. 13 4.2 Licensee must not reapply for a medical license in the State of Oregon for at least two years from the effective date of this Order. 14 Licensee must obey all federal and Oregon state laws and regulations pertaining 15 4.3 16 to the practice of medicine.
