ORDER

On the 7th day of November, 1997, came on to be heard before representatives of the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners ("the Board"), the petition of Keith E. Kesler, D.O. ("Petitioner") requesting termination of a Board Order entered on January 14, 1994 and pertaining to Petitioner's Texas medical license G-9758.


Petitioner appeared in person, without counsel, before representatives R. Russell Thomas, Jr., D.O., a member of the Board, and Robert C. Henderson, II, M.D., a District Review Committee member. Information concerning the petition was considered and Petitioner argued for termination of the Order.

Based on Petitioner's record of rehabilitation, the changes he has effected in his practice and upon the recommendation of his monitoring physician, the Board representatives recommend that the termination request be GRANTED.

Based on the available information and the recommendation of the Board representatives, the Board ORDERS that the Petition is GRANTED and the Order is hereby TERMINATED.
