ORDER

On the 8th day of January, 1997, came on to be heard before representatives of the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners ("the Board"), the petition of Mark Alan Williamson, M.D., ("Petitioner") requesting termination of a Board Order entered on January 6, 1995, and pertaining to Petitioner's Texas medical license, H-4855.


Petitioner appeared in person, without counsel, before representative Margaret L. Ford, Ed.D., a member of the Board. Information concerning the petition was considered and Petitioner argued for termination of the Order.

Based on Petitioner's history of compliance, his cooperation with Board staff, his three year period of documented sobriety, and his service to his community, the Board representative recommends that the termination request be GRANTED.

Based on the available information and the recommendation of the Board representative, the Board ORDERS that the Petition is GRANTED and the Order is hereby TERMINATED.
