Dear Dr. Gadgil,

The Texas Medical Board has received proof of the following information:

1. You currently hold Texas Medical Board License No. T-9002.
2. You were issued your Texas License through the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact.
3. On March 20, 2024, the Nebraska Medical Board suspended your license to practice medicine based on findings of unprofessional conduct, habitual intoxication and providing professional services while under the influence of alcohol.
4. On April 3, 2024, the Maryland Medical Board suspended your license to practice medicine based on Nebraska's findings and suspension of your license relating to unprofessional conduct, habitual intoxication and providing professional services while under the influence of alcohol.

Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Section 171.010 (d):

If a license granted to a physician by a member board is revoked, surrendered or relinquished in lieu of discipline, or suspended, then any license issued to the physician by any other member board shall be suspended, automatically and immediately without further action necessary by the other member board, for 90 days upon entry of the order by the disciplining board, to permit the member board to investigate the basis for the action under the medical practice act of that state.

THEREFORE, your Texas Medical Board License No. T-9002 is hereby **SUSPENDED IMMEDIATELY** and effective, by operation of law, pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Section 171.010(d) on April 16<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

The suspension is effective until superseded by further action of the Board in accordance with Chapter 6 of the IMLCC Rules and the Texas Occupations Code.
