ORDER


On the 16th day of March, 1995, came on to be heard before representatives of the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners ("the Board"), the petition of Robert Lewis Mims, M.D., ("Petitioner") requesting termination of a Board Order entered on March 26, 1993, and pertaining to Petitioner's Texas medical license, F-9827.

Petitioner appeared in person, without counsel, before representatives Terri L. Stewart, Ph.D., a member of the Board, and Allan D. Axelrad, M.D., a District Review Committee member. Information concerning the petition was considered and Petitioner argued for termination of the Order.

Based on Petitioner's candor and insight since entry of the Order, his history of compliance, and because he has complied with virtually all terms and conditions of the Order, the Board representatives recommend that the termination request be GRANTED.

Based on the available information and the recommendation of the Board representatives, the Board ORDERS that the Petition is GRANTED and the Order is hereby TERMINATED.
