STIPULATION AND ORDER
DIRECTING CORRECTIVE ACTION

COMES NOW the Medical Disciplinary Board and respondent,
by and through their respective counsel of record, and
stipulate as follows:

I. STIPULATION

1. Respondent is fully apprised of both the nature and
severity of the allegations set forth in the Statement of
Charges of Unprofessional Conduct filed against him.

2. Respondent is fully apprised of the fact that the
State is prepared to proceed to a hearing upon the merits of
said Statement of Charges.

3. Respondent is fully apprised, with the advice and
assistance of his counsel of record, that should the State in
fact prove at said hearing the allegations as set forth in
paragraph II of the Statement of Charges, the Board has the
power and authority to issue a directive of corrective action.

4. Respondent is fully apprised, with the advice and
assistance of his counsel of record, that he has the right to
defend himself by presenting evidence in his behalf at said
hearing.

5. Respondent wishes to expedite the resolution of this
matter by means of stipulation.

6. This agreement is not binding unless accepted by the Medical Disciplinary Board.

II. CORRECTIVE ACTION

7. I waive my right to proceed to a hearing on the merits of the Statement of Charges.

8. I agree to perform the following requirements: a) I shall undergo psychiatric evaluation by Dr. Irwin Dreiblatt, at my expense, and will follow any recommendations of Dr. Dreiblatt. This evaluation shall be completed within 60 days of the signing of the Order. b) I shall attend and verify my attendance in at least one Continuing Medical Education seminar dealing with the problems associated with opposite sex patients; c) I shall submit written annual reports, for three (3) years, to the Medical Disciplinary Board, describing any and all complaints from female patients regarding sexual advances, describing my attendance at the above mentioned Continuing Medical Education, and describing my involvement in Dr. Dreiblatt's recommended follow-up care.

I hereby certify that I have read this stipulation and agreement in its entirety, that my counsel of record has fully explained the legal significance and consequences thereof; that I fully understand all of same, and in witness whereof I affix my signature this Nov. 8 day of November, 1986.

STATEMENT OF CHARGES

MICHAEL J. MURPHY, Secretary of the Washington State Medical Disciplinary Board, and acting in that capacity, states and alleges as follows:

I.

The respondent has been issued a license to practice medicine by the state of Washington.

II.

That the respondent has engaged in unprofessional conduct in the year 1984 consisting of inappropriate, sexual overtures to a patient, [REDACTED] which conduct was non-consensual, non-medical and unprivileged.

III.

That the foregoing specifications constitute grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to RCW 18.72.030(1), which defines unprofessional conduct to include: the commission of any act involving moral turpitude, dishonesty, or corruption, whether the same be committed in the course of his or her relations as


a physician, or otherwise, and whether the same constitutes a crime or not.

WHEREFORE, Michael J. Murphy, alleges that the conduct referred to in this statement of charges affects the public health, safety and welfare, that a notice be issued and served as provided by law to the respondent giving him the opportunity to defend against the accusations of this statement of charges, and provided that if he shall fail to defend against these accusations, that he shall be subject to such discipline as is appropriate under RCW 18.72.230.
